## Setting up the Olympus DS-5000 to Record in DSS Classic Mode

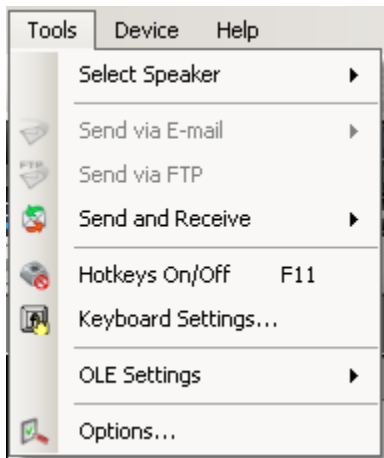
The Olympus DS-5000 defaults to the DSS Pro audio format (.ds2 file extension). Unfortunately, this file format is not supported by Express Scribe and many other transcription software programs. However, it is easy to configure the DS-5000 to record in DSS Classic mode thereby making it compatible with traditional transcription software programs. When the DS-5000 is configured to record in DSS Classic Mode, it is fully compatible with any transcription program that works with the DS-4000.

To configure the DS-5000 to record in DSS Classic mode so its recordings are compatible with Express Scribe, follow these steps:

Start the Olympus DSS Player Pro software by clicking Start, Olympus DSS Player Pro, Dictation Module.



Select Tools then Options from the main DSS Pro menu.

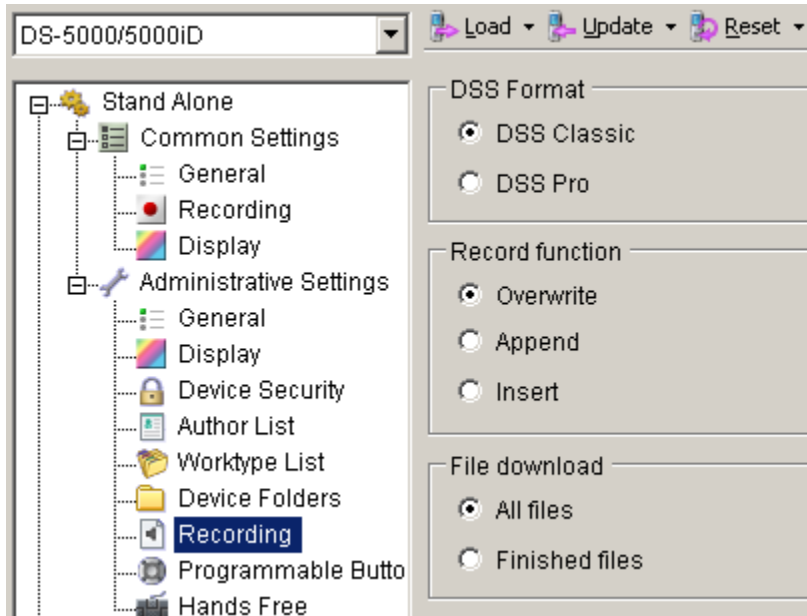


At the top of the options setting window, click Device.

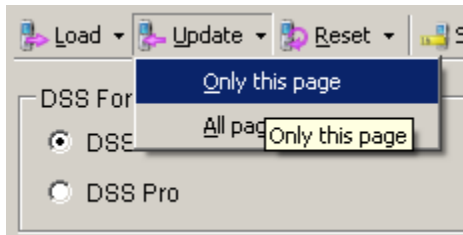




Make sure that the DS-5000 is inserted in its cradle and is turned on. Click on the Recording option in the left margin of the options window. Then select "DSS Classic" in the box labeled "DSS Format".



Finally, click the update button and then click "Only this page" to update your device. This final step updates the DS-5000 so that it is now configured to record in DSS Classic mode (.dss file extension) and will be fully compatible with Express Scribe.
